#### C. Eligibility Criteria (for admission to FYJC Class)

- Students who have passed the SSC examination or its equivalent examination from Maharashtra Board or any other Board recognized by the Government.
- The College enjoys the status of Jain Minority Institution. Other categories for admission are Open merit.

#### D. Categories under which the students can apply:

- 1. Open Merit
- 2. Jain Minority
- 3. Sports and Cultural Activities
- 4. Government Transfer Cases, Defence, Freedom Fighters, Ex-Servicemen Handicapped.
- Admission to the FYJC Class is through the online process implemented by the Deputy Director's Office of the Government of Maharashtra. Applicants are requested to read the newspapers for the information and procedure.
- Admission to the F.Y.J.C. will be as per the online system introduced by the Government of Maharashtra. Hence students are expected to visit the site. <a href="http://hnccsolapur.org">http://hnccsolapur.org</a> and apply online.

#### **E.** List of Required Documents

- Documents to be submitted by students who have passed SSC Examination from Maharashtra State Board at the time of admission are:
  - 1. Admission form duly completed
  - 2. Original Mark Sheet + 2 attested photocopies
  - 3. Original School Leaving Certificate +2 attested photocopies
  - 4. Aadhaar Card 2 Photocopies
  - 5. Passport Size Photograph 4 Copies
  - 6. Fees have to be paid on the day of admission

- Photo copies should be attested by original signature and not rubber stamp signature.
- Students are advised in their own interest, that before submitting certificates, mark sheets etc., in the original to the College office, they should retain true copies of the documents with themselves. The Original School Leaving Certificate or Transference Certificate will be kept by the College permanently and under no circumstances will it be given back to the students. Hence, students should keep sufficient number of photocopies of School Leaving or Transference Certificates with them.
